The curriculum at MFUMC Preschool is based upon *Wonder-Filled Weekdays* by Abingdon Press. This curriculum is organized around units of study, each of which is designed to help your child develop in every aspect of his or her life. This material is supplemented from time to time, and all material used at MFUMC Preschool is scripturally and educationally sound.

Because MFUMC Preschool is a ministry of this local church, spiritual training of the children is an important facet of our program. We have prayers everyday, Bible stories each week, and Chapel once a month. Children also participate in weekly music classes and have opportunities to share at programs what they've learned throughout the year. After a morning of learning, the children have snack (provided by parent volunteers) and then have the opportunity for some much deserved play time.

During the school year, your child is encouraged to make friends with his or her classmates, to increase ability to obey rules, and to develop fine and gross motor skills. We strive to help the children understand the world around them through their studies and exposure to other cultures. The three- and four-year olds also have the opportunity to go on various field trips throughout the year. It is also our goal to help these children master the academic knowledge needed to make them successful in elementary school.

First United Methodist Church Preschool is a ministry and educational program of Monroe First United Methodist Church. It is under the supervision of the Weekday Preschool Board and operates in accordance with the policies of the Church Council and Trustees of our church.

Our program has been planned for the total development of your child's mental, emotional, social, physical, and spiritual skills. Our goal is to give each child the loving care, guidance, and security needed for these important, formative years.

As parents, you are always welcome to visit with us, participate in our activities, ask questions and make suggestions.

Age Requirements

The classes at MFUMC Preschool are divided according to age. Children beginning our toddler program must be one year old by September 1st. We also have classes for 2's, 3's, and 4's. Each child will be assigned to a class according to his or her age by September 1st. All 3 and 4-year-old students must be toilet trained.

Tuition

2 day classes	\$140.00 per month
3 day classes	\$155.00 per month
5 day classes	\$180.00 per month

Upon registration, a non-refundable fee equal to one month's tuition is due.

MFUMC Preschool is a self-supporting, non-profit organization. We operate our program solely on the funds provided by tuition and registration fees. All money is used by the program to provide the best possible teachers, equipment and supplies.

Extra-Curricular Activities

Students have the opportunity to participate in Pre-Gym and Pre-Ballet classes taught by Creative Movement and Dance. These classes are optional and are conducted immediately following regular school hours. More information is available upon request.



Music is included in the students' weekly class schedule, and is viewed as an integral part of the learning process.

Lunch Bunch

This is a program available as an extension of the preschool day. It gives children the opportunity to eat lunch with friends as well as explore the world around them.
